

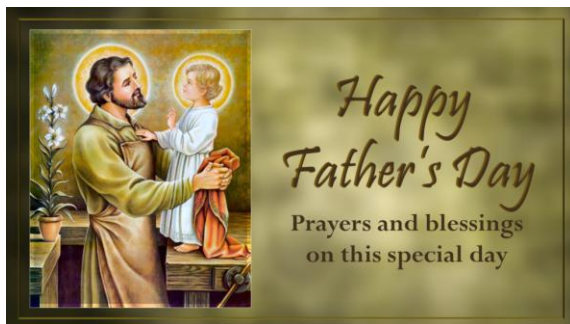

DIOCESAN EVENTS

Until Sunday, June 21, the MAiD Safeguards petition will be available at the back of the Church. The petition asks the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan to implement two safeguards, similar to those already in place in other Canadian provinces. First - Prohibit unsolicited offers of MAiD to any patient. (If the patient does not bring up MAiD, healthcare professionals would not be allowed to offer or ask the patient about MAiD, or the possibility of choosing MAiD.) Second - Protect healthcare providers who choose not to aid in the provision of MAiD from professional or legal repercussions. All parishioners are invited and encouraged to sign this petition. If you would like a copy of the petition to share with family and friends, please visit the Prince Albert Diocesan website, where a link to the petition is available in the slideshow at the top of the homepage. On the Diocesan website, using the same link to access the petition, you will find the recording of the 'MAiD for You?' presentation on the Diocesan Pastoral Care Page. It outlines the expansion of MAiD in Canada and explains why we should be concerned.

June 21, 2026

Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's readings call us to tackle the challenging issues of fear and trust — two concepts that must be confronted and dealt with by all of us who wish to live the stewardship way of life.

The Lord knows that facing down our fears and choosing to trust Him with all areas of our lives is an ongoing challenge for us. He is generous with reassurances to us throughout the Scriptures. Today's Gospel passage from Matthew is a case in point. In the span of eight verses, Jesus addresses the topic of fear four times.

“Fear no one.”

“Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul.”

“Rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body.”

“So do not be afraid.”

And the reassurance continues. **“Are not two sparrows sold for a small coin? Yet not one of them falls to the ground without your Father's knowledge. Even all the hairs of your head are counted.”** Notice that Jesus says, “your Father” in describing God's intimate knowledge and tender care for each one of us. He is truly “Abba,” our Dad, Who knows us inside and out.

With that, let us all breathe a huge sigh of relief. All is well. Our Father knows us through and through, sent His Son to save us, and will always take care of us.

Let's stop wasting any more time with fear. Instead, let's put all our energy, all our time, our talents, and our treasure into trusting this great and loving God, using all that we are and all that He has given us to bring Him glory.
