30th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Oct. 25th & 26th, 2025

1. Thank you for your kind and generous support of the Fall Supper so far. Things are really coming together. We still need about 50 lbs. of potatoes, cooked and mashed, 100 lbs. of cooked carrots, 4 hundred more spring rolls, 14 dozen buns, 8 more desserts, and more salads. If there are any more volunteers who can do a 2-hour shift in the kitchen, we would appreciate hearing from you. Of course, if you would prefer, you can make a cash donation which will definitely help with the purchase of turkeys, ham, rutabagas, and paper products needed for the supper.
2. Last weekend we began distributing ticket books for the fundraising committee's Lottery Ticket Raffle. If you did not get yours, please stop at the back after mass and ask for one. Because we have many parishioners who are not registered with the parish, your name may not have been on our list. It would be helpful to us, if you take the time to pick up a parish registration form at the same time, fill it out and return it to us.
3. Because All Souls' Day falls on Sunday, Nov. 2nd, the same day as our Fall Supper, we will have our annual Memorial Day Mass on Tuesday, Nov. 4, at 7:00 pm. This is the mass where we remember all the loved ones who have passed away since Nov. 1, 2024. If you would like to include a loved one in this service, whose funeral was not in our parish, please bring a picture of your loved to the parish office by Oct. 29.
4. The anchor/cross is now making the rounds of Deanery 5. It will be coming to our parish on Saturday, Nov. 8 & Sunday, Nov. 9. During the week, it will visit Villa Pascal, St. Mary School & Notre Dame School. You are invited to prepare for the arrival of the anchor/cross by picking up intercessory prayer cards on which you may place your prayer intentions. These papers can be kept and placed directly in the box accompanying the anchor, or you may place them in the box which we have under the St. Kateri statue, to be transferred later.
5. Also, for anyone interested in knowing more about indulgences during the Jubilee year, some more pamphlets, identical to those published earlier in the year, are again available in the entrance.
