Palm Sunday – Mar. 28th & 29th, 2026

1. We are still graciously accepting donations towards Development and Peace – Caritas Canada's annual fundraising Share Lent Campaign. If you did not have a chance to contribute on Solidarity Sunday, please place your donation in the brown envelopes you see in the pews or in the entrance. Please pick up a Development and Peace prayer card as a thank you from the organization.
2. There will be Mass tomorrow morning, Monday, March 30, at 9:30 am in the parish, and no mass on Tuesday morning at 9:30 am. Father will be travelling to Prince Albert on Tuesday for the annual Chrism Mass for the Diocese, at 6:30 pm. Everyone is welcome to attend.
3. Holy Thursday Mass will be at 7:00 pm, followed by Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until midnight. We encourage parishioners to sign up, so that there is someone keeping vigil each hour. The collection on Holy Thursday will be for the migrants and asylum-seeking youth in Israel. This will allow them to access better educational opportunities, child care, and jobs.
4. A reminder that Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence. On Good Friday, we will gather for the Stations of the Cross at 2:00 pm. The celebration of the Passion of the Lord will begin at 3:00 pm. The Good Friday collection is taken at the request of the Holy See.
5. We invite anyone wishing to get water blessed at the Easter Vigil to please bring your container of water and place it near the Holy Water Font at the front. We also invite those who wish to donate money towards the purchase of flowers for Easter to place your donation in the collection basket.
6. Now, please follow along in your bulletin, or on the screen, as we pray together the Prayer for a New Bishop.
