### Body and Blood of Christ – June 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026

1. Everyone is invited to view the award-winning film “Life Worth Living”, on Tuesday, June 16, at 7:00 pm in St. Bernadette Hall. This film explains what has happened in Canada, while featuring important personal stories related to euthanasia. On June 17, it will be 10 years since euthanasia was made legal in Canada. The law was expanded in 2021 by removing the requirement that a person be terminally ill to be killed. Canada is currently scheduled to extend euthanasia to people with a mental illness alone in March 2027. The Euthanasia Prevention Coalition urges Canadians to sign the petition in support of Bill C-128.
2. Again, we remind you to sign the petition at the back of the church. First – to prohibit unsolicited offers of MAiD to any patient, and second to protect healthcare providers, who choose not to aid in the provision of MAiD, from professional or legal repercussions.
