1. When a loved one dies, it can feel like you are alone. Few people understand how painful and isolating your grief can be. But that does not mean you have to suffer by yourself. At Grief Share, you will find a safe, comforting space where you can talk to others about your grief. You will find support, direction and guidance on how to make it through. A new round of GriefShare sessions is starting August 24th, at St. Joseph Calasactius Church Hall. There is a Monday afternoon group from 1:30 to 3:00 pm, and a Monday evening group which goes from 7:00 to 8:30 pm. Call one of the numbers on the poster to register.

If you know of a family member or a friend who is interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, or who wishes to be baptized or initiated into the Catholic Church, please ask them to call the parish office and register for RCIA classes which will begin this fall, dates to be announced. We will also be taking registrations for children aged 7-17, who wish to be baptized, confirmed and receive First Holy Communion. They will begin RCIC classes in January of 2027, and be eligible to receive the sacraments in May or June when the bishop is next scheduled in our parish.
